A roll call of officers and delegates was held, followed by the reading of the minutes from the previous meeting which were approved as read.

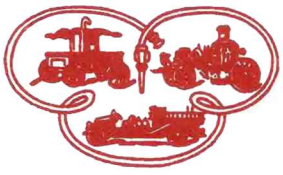
2 corrections \$500 donation from the prison for grass mowing and \$20 payable to Heller gas

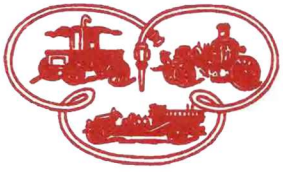
There were 26 members, 8 past presidents, and 0 guests representing 14 companies in attendance.
